Theme: Reframing the maritime decarbonisation roadmap: addressing fuel, technology and infrastructure bottlenecks

The Marine Energy Transition Forum returns to London in November 2026 to examine the bottlenecks hindering maritime decarbonisation and explore the solutions needed to keep the industry on track towards its greenhouse gas reduction goals.
